



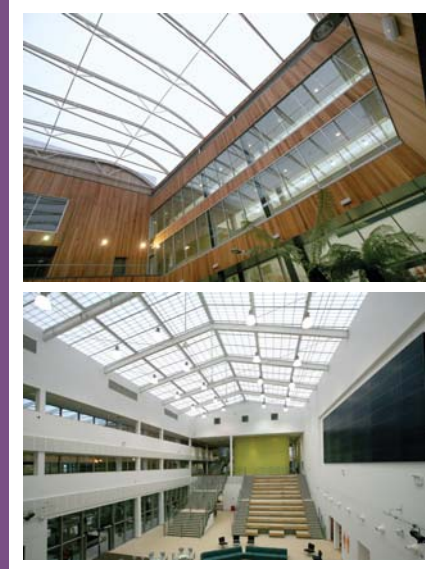
The 21st Century Learning Alliance

The 21st Century Learning Alliance was founded in 2006 to ensure that learning communities of all kinds have the best chance possible to prepare young people for the various challenges they will face in the future.

The 21st Century Learning Alliance award is now in its second year. Through the award, the Alliance is looking to identify and **celebrate the achievements of schools** that are excelling in how they approach key areas of their work or environment. The four areas to be considered for the award are:

- teaching and learning methods.
- people, resources and the curriculum.
- time.
- space.



The deadline for entries to this scheme is 3 April 2009.

Shortlisted schools will be visited by judges during the middle of May 2009. The winning school will be announced at the NCSL conference, which takes place on 10-12 June 2009.
